Organizations who share these goals can request a grant not to exceed \$5,000. The Committee will review applications and may contact applicants for further information/clarification.

GUIDELINES

St. Anne's Grants Committee gives preference to projects and organizations that:

- Address humanitarian needs locally
- Embody a mission of love and empowerment
- Have direct involvement of St. Anne's Parishioners
- Demonstrate a record of success
- Seek to make a positive impact on people's lives
- Have results that can be measured

St. Anne's Grants Committee does NOT generally fund:

• Physical structures or the purchase of capital equipment
