Other a cappella music of Benjamin Britten, Sydney Guillaume, Robert Parsons, John Williams, James MacMillan and Arvo Part will be performed

The PING vocal ensemble was founded in 2011 by Professor Larry Vote and a number of students keenly interested in the performance of choral music by a small group of singers. With the inception of the group as one of the official choral groups of St. Mary's College of Maryland, the PING ensemble offers the opportunity for students to strive for excellence in the performance of choral music from all ages. PING has performed throughout the Mid-Atlantic region in tours of High Schools and in such venues as Washington National Cathedral and at the Alba Music Festival in Alba, Italy. Their concerts in the acoustically exquisite Reconstructed Chapel at Historic St. Mary's City have become special events for the community and are given in the fall and spring.
